An @Home Learning Activity

Alphabet Scavenger Hunt

Introduction:

As you complete this activity, you will find words that start with the letters of the alphabet.

Materials:

You'll each need a pen or pencil and a piece of paper.

Directions:

Student: On a piece of paper, make a list of things you might see on a walk around your neighborhood. List one item for each letter of the alphabet. For example, your list might include a tree that starts with the letter A, a license plate that starts with the letter B, a flower that starts with the letter C, a store that starts with the letter D, and so on.

Family Partner: On another piece of paper, make a list of things you might see on a walk around your neighborhood. List one item for each letter of the alphabet.

Student and Family Partner: Exchange lists and together go on a walk around your neighborhood. Write down the items you find next to their correct letters. The person who finds the most items on his or her list is the winner!

Talk About It:

Name 3 things you saw on your walk that you didn't expect to see.

Learn More:

Take a walk every day until you find everything on your lists.
